Objects (Choose one)

bike school lunch candy bar video game soccer ball

Setting (Choose one)

at someone's house in a park in the classroom
lunch area at a store in a car

Characters (Choose two)

Tony – fifth-grade boy Jessica – seventh-grade girl
Maria – fifth-grade girl Tyler – seventh-grade boy
Joseph – fifth-grade boy David – eighth-grade boy
Jasmine – fifth-grade girl Katie – eighth-grade girl

Tips for Writing Your Play

Write your play like this:

Setting: Tony and Maria are at the park after school.

Tony: Write what Tony says.

Maria: Write what Maria says.

Add feelings or actions:

Tony: (Angry) What's going on here!

Maria: (Stomps off mad.) Nothing!
