

- A.** Spend some spare time reviewing Lesson 3 by asking:
- What are the main steps in the juvenile court system?
(The steps are arrest, juvenile hall, released or stay in juvenile hall, petition, arraignment, trial [not open to the public] and sentencing hearing.)
 - What are some differences between the juvenile justice system and the adult system?
(Juveniles are taken to juvenile hall and adults are taken to jail. In the juvenile justice system there is no jury and the proceedings are private, but in the adult system there is a jury and the proceedings are open to the public. The juvenile justice system focuses on rehabilitation whereas the adult system focuses on punishment, etc.)
- B.** Distribute Handout 3E. This is a crossword puzzle based on Lesson 3. When students complete it, review the answers.
